Our Inspiration

St. Montfort was a great scholar, a powerful speaker and an author of spiritual works. He never bothered about the consequences of telling the 'truth' and doing what was right before the eyes of God. He was victimized by the world for his honesty and conviction. He established many dedicated groups of men and women to carry on his good work, particularly instructing the young. One such organization is the Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel.

About Us:

Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel

Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel is a Religious Society of Christian Brothers founded by St. Louis Marie Grignon De Montfort. Montfort is the name of a village in Brittany, France and it is the birthplace of St. Louis Marie. Hence he is popularly known as St. Montfort. He lived between January 31, 1673 and on April 28, 1716. During his 43 years of life on earth, he preached the word of God (Good News) all over France, built schools and hospitals and founded three congregations known as Sisters of Wisdom, Company of Mary and Montfort Brothers of St. Gabriel. The Congregation of Montfort Brothers was established primarily for teaching and uplifting the poor and marginalized. The Brothers are carrying on the apostolate in 34 countries in the world through educational institutions. (General, Technical and special ones for physically disabled).

In the year 1903, three Brothers of French origin came to India and established the First Industrial School at Tindivanam, Tamilnadu. In 2003, they completed 100 years of service to this nation. In the year 2016 they celebrated the tricentennial of the feast of St. Montfort. At present the Brothers have more than 200 educational Institutions in Eight Provinces all over India. Some of the best schools like St. Paul's Aizwal, Loyola Patna, Montfort Delhi, Little Flower Hyderabad, Campion Trichy, Santhome Chennai, and Montfort Yercaud in India are owned and administered by them. Montfort College and many such educational institutions all over India and abroad are administered by the followers of St. Montfort under the banner of Brothers of St. Gabriel.



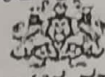



The sustainable development framework rests on four pillars – **society, environment, culture and economy**. Thus, it envisages a future in which there is a balance between social, economic, cultural and environmental objectives. The United Nations Conference on Sustainable Development, or Rio+20, agreed on a range of measures to establish Sustainable Development Goals, or SDGs. "Through a widely inclusive consultative process that included governments, civil society, industry, research bodies and others, 17 SDGs were decided upon. The first seven correspond roughly to the Millennium Development Goals in the social sphere, such as gender equality, education and health; the next five deal with economic issues like inclusive growth, resilient infrastructure, sustainable consumption etc.; the next three address the environment, through climate change, oceans, and land degradation; and finally, the last two deal with promoting peaceful societies and partnerships for sustainable development. Impressive economic growth has turned India into an important player in international Geopolitical system in the 21st century. Its profile has been influencing the course of politics at the regional as well as global level. The Seminar was conceived as a platform to discuss these issues among eminent scholars, practitioners and all other stakeholders in the concerned fields. Objectives of the seminar were as listed below;

Objectives:

The 2030 agenda also calls upon member states, in accordance with their national specific contexts and priorities, to learn lessons from past efforts, to build on existing initiatives and successful models and bring together ongoing efforts towards sustainable development. It recognizes and encourages the development of different visions and approaches within countries in order to address continuing inequalities.

- To bring together success stories, best practices, ongoing efforts at national and regional levels and lessons learnt, that can guide the achievement of SDG targets.
- To better understand the concept of sustainable development – development that fully integrates the need to promote prosperity, well-being and protection of the environment.
- To make use of this Seminar as a key channel of information sharing to promote, display and disseminate information on various sustainable development issues.
- To upgrade the level of knowledge and skills of the stakeholders to identify, organize and address in a better way.
- To transfer the information and resources for further facilitating and sharing knowledge with user communities.

And the topic of the seminar was divided under the below given broad themes (not restricted):

- Eradication of extreme Poverty and Hunger
- Equal and Quality education
- Gender equality and women's empowerment
- Health and Nutrition
- Climate and Environmental sustainability
- Studies on indigenous population
- Development of sustainable living areas (Urban & Rural)

The seminar was jointly conducted by Department of Political Science, GNWS First Grade Arts and Commerce College Kalaghatagi, Centre for Holistic Development and Research, Kalaghatagi, Centre for Bio Cultural Studies(CBiCS), MAHE, Manipal and Karnatak University College Political Science Teachers' Forum, Dharwad on 13 and 14 March 2020, on the topic **A National Seminar on Sustainable Development in India: Contemporary Challenges and Opportunities**. At Montfort Auditorium, Good News Campus, Kalaghatgi.

The seminar was inaugurated by Dr S. S. Patagundi, ICSSR Senior Fellow, CMDR, Dharwad and delivered an inaugural speech. He mentioned about the history and importance of the sustainable development and the steps taken by the world leader to initiate Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). He made it clear that wherever we find Over Use of anything, it is going to create a much bigger problem, if not now may be in future. In this juncture, it was very essential to think about the life now and in future by utilizing the existing resources. The major point here is the responsibility of saving, growing, and handing over it to coming generation comes along with the right of utilizing any resources. Dr Patagundi stressed on the importance of having a mechanism for its checks and balances. He also mentioned that many treaties, laws, regulations brought and Sustainable Development Goals came into existence as a part of creating checks and balances on this unscientific, greedy over use of natural resources. Stability, sustainability are also expanded to the lives and its style of living, growth and development. He mentioned about the developmental stages of this sustainable goals adopted by whole world leaders.

Keynote address was given by Dr S. T. Bagalakoti, Professor, DoS in Economics, Karnatak University, Dharwad. He shed light on many important aspects and associated factors of the topic. He explained basics and the background of it very well so that audience could understand it in proper way. He started with a very basic question that what is Development. Whether construction of roads and constructing multistoried buildings is a development? Whether earning much money and spending it is a development? Then further, he said NO, it is not a development. He mentioned about two major ideologies of the 1990s that were almost celebrated in whole world; Capitalism and Socialism. Socialism dissipated and capitalism came into forefront but under the mask of Neo liberalism. During this time, Governments had to provide all the necessary support to set the industries and run them. In the same time the definition of development was changed, before that, economists measured that increased income as development but many social scientists opposed and said that mere increase in income should not be called as development. Instead, that income should translate into necessities of the people viz... Education, Employment, electricity, health facilities etc... Later dr Amarthya Sen developed Human Development Index (HDI) and a notion of environmentally responsible development brought into the board to check the disadvantages caused by developmental programmes. It was the major step taken to make everyone responsible in overall development.

Prof. B. G. Bidari (Principal, GNWS PU College, Kalaghatagi), Dr. B. G. Biradar (Principal, Good News First Grade College, Kalaghatgi), Prof. M. S. Muragodmath (Coordinator, IQAC), were present.

The session was chaired by Rev. Bro. Niju Thomas (Vice-President, GNW Society, Kalghatagi) and gave a presidential remark. He appreciated the efforts of seminar director and the convener to organizing such a good seminar in the college. He also thanked ICSSR for due to it was the first ever seminar organized in the college. He expressed his wish to organize such programmes again in the providing the assistance and expressed his wish to organize such programmes again in the campus of college for the benefit of the students and rural folk in the area. Dr. Vijaykumar R Betgar (Seminar Director) was welcomed and introduced the guests to the gathering, Dr. Mahesh Horakeri (Organizing Secretary) given vote of thanks and the Master of Ceremony was Dr Praveen Hoogar (Seminar Convener) for the inaugural session.

We were accepted 20 papers to present in the seminar and those papers were divided into total 6 sessions for two days; each session was scheduled with an invited speech and paper presentations. Themes of the sessions were as listed below;
